

Qualification & Eligibility Criteria

1) General Physician, Surgeon (General Surgery), Obstetrician and Gynecologist, Pathologist And Biochemist, Radiologist, Anesthetist

Essential Qualification: Post-Graduate Medical Degree in Concerned Subject Recognized By the National Medical Commission. General Physician to Have Specialization in Emergency Medicines.

2) Residential Medical Officer (RMO)

Essential Qualification: Recognized degree qualification in homoeopathy with experience as house physician for a period of not less than two years in a recognized homoeopathic hospital after obtaining regular registration from a State Board of homoeopathy.

3) Medical Officer

Essential Qualification: Recognized degree qualification In Homoeopathy with experience for a period of not less than one year as a House Physician In a recognized Homoeopathic Hospital.

4) House Physician (Resident)

Essential Qualification: Recognized degree qualification In Homoeopathy and having regular registration from a state board of Homoeopathy with professional experience for a period of not less than two years; Provided that the post of house physician (resident) in permitted post-graduate college shall not be separately required as post-graduate students in first of Doctor of Medicine (Homoeopathy) course shall be doing house job compulsorily.

5) Yoga Instructor or Physician

Essential Qualification: Qualified degree holder (bachelor of Naturopathy and yogic sciences - a five and half years regular medical course in yoga and naturopathy or diploma in naturopathy and yogic science) having the registration to practice these systems of health care from the State or Central authorities.

6) Physiotherapist

Essential Qualification: A degree in physiotherapy recognized by the State Government concerned.

7) Dietician

Essential Qualification: A degree in diet and nutrition recognized by the State Government concerned.

8) Public Relation Officer

Essential Qualification: A bachelor's degree in communications, public relations, journalism, or a related field is often preferred.

9) Pharmacist

Essential Qualification: Graduate in any stream along with experience of three years of working in homoeopathic pharmacy and preference shall be given to the candidates having Diploma in pharmacy.

10) Laboratory Technician

Essential Qualification: Recognized Bachelor of Science degree along with Medical laboratory technology from a recognized University or institutions.

11) X-Ray Technician or Radiographer

Essential Qualification: Must have a diploma in radiology from a recognized University or institutions.

12) Nursing Staff In-Charge

Essential Qualification: Must possess a Bachelor of Science degree or General Nursing and Midwifery in nursing and registered under Nursing Council of the State concerned with two years of experience.

13) Nurse

Essential Qualification: Must possess a Bachelor of Science degree or General Nursing and Midwifery or Auxiliary Nurse and Midwifery in nursing registered under nursing council of State concerned. One year experience of working in homoeopathic hospital.

14) Store Keeper

Essential Qualification: Must have passed senior secondary from a recognized Board with knowledge of computer.

15) Registration Clerk or Receptionist

Essential Qualification: (i) Must have passed senior secondary from a recognized Board (ii) Must have knowledge of regional language, English and proficiency in computer operation.
