Subject: Guidelines on Social Media Usage and Avoidance of Prohibited Content by Students and Staff of Ganpat University

Ganpat University upholds the values of integrity, responsibility, and respectful conduct in both academic and social environments. Considering the increasing reliance on social media platforms, the following guidelines are hereby issued for strict compliance by all students and staff:

1. Responsible Social Media Usage

- All students and staff must use social media responsibly and in alignment with the values of Ganpat University.
- Content shared on personal or public platforms must not harm the dignity, reputation, or interests of the University, its stakeholders, or society at large.

2. Prohibited Content

- Uploading or circulating **any content related to Ganpat University, its constituent institutes, or its stakeholders without prior permission of the competent authority will be considered an offensive act** and will invite disciplinary measures.
- Creation, uploading, or circulation of any content that is defamatory, obscene, offensive, misleading, politically or religiously controversial, or otherwise prohibited under law is strictly forbidden.
- **Content that promotes or incites hatred, discrimination, or violence against individuals or groups based on attributes such as race, religion, caste, gender, disability, or sexual orientation is strictly prohibited.**
- Such content, even if shared from personal accounts, will not be considered the responsibility of the University.

3. Disciplinary Action

- Any violation of these guidelines will invite strict disciplinary measures against the concerned student or staff member.
- Depending on the severity of the act, action may include a written warning, suspension, termination of services, cancellation of admission, or any other measure deemed appropriate by the University authorities.

4. Advisory

- All members of the University community are strongly advised to avoid creation or circulation of prohibited or controversial content.
- Everyone is encouraged to promote positive, constructive, and ethical use of social media.



5. University Disclaimer

- Ganpat University shall not be held accountable for any personal social media activities of students or staff. The responsibility for such activities lies solely with the individual concerned.

This circular is issued in the interest of maintaining discipline, ethical conduct, and the reputation of Ganpat University.
